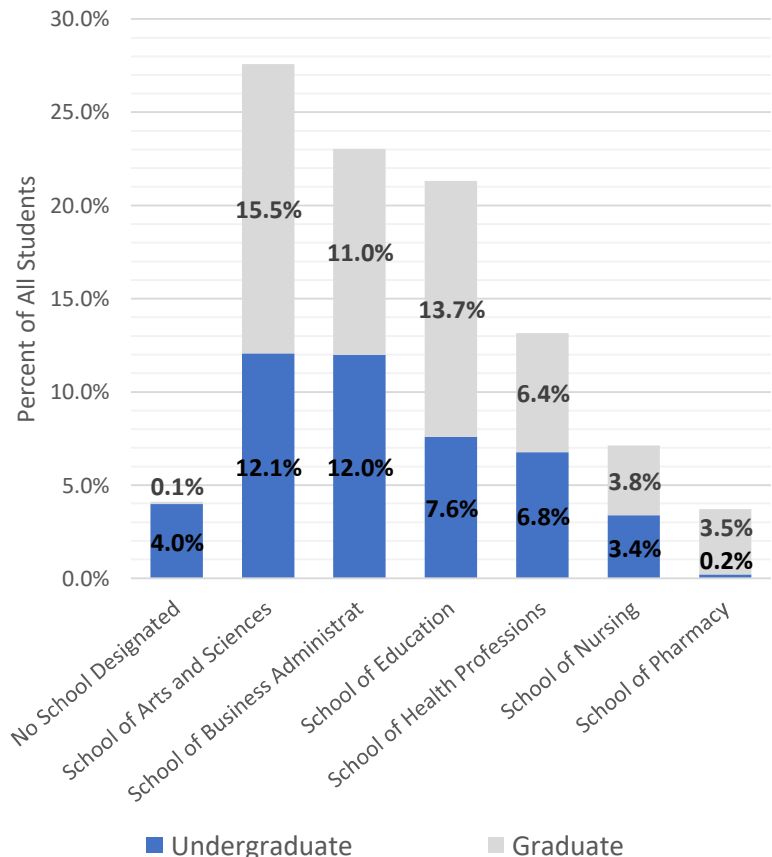
Fall 2024 Census Enrollment: 5,274

- Undergraduate Tuition (full-time (12-18 credits): **\$17,475/semester or \$34,950/year**
- Resident Room & Board: **\$6,600 per semester or \$13,200/year**
- **99.6%** of traditional undergraduate students that receive and utilize financial aid

Full Prior Year Enrollment (2023-2024): 6,833

- Undergraduate: 3,192
Graduate: 3,701
- Student to Faculty Ratio: 12 to 1
- **78.26%** of Traditional Full Time New Freshmen Undergraduates in Fall 2022 (202310) returned for their Sophomore Year in Fall 2023 (202410)
- **64.3%** of Traditional Undergraduate students graduated within 6 years (National Average 64%)

What our Spring 2024 Graduates are saying according to our Survey of Graduates (684 Graduates surveyed; 33% response rate):

- **87%** of our graduates agreed that they are better prepared to serve and lead by putting the needs of others first.
- **86%** agreed that their academic program helped them to develop skills to be successful (critical thinking, communication, use of technology).
